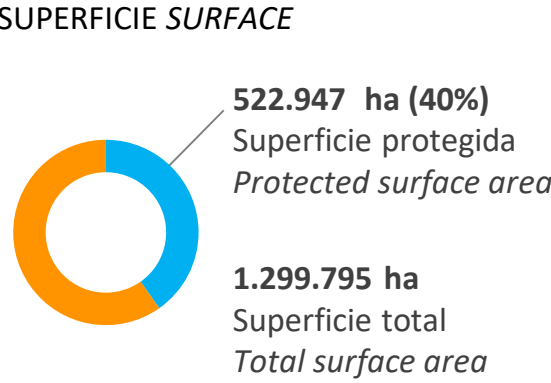

Breve descripción	La Reserva de Biosfera Occidental de Nghe An fue reconocida oficialmente por la Organización de las Naciones Unidas para la Educación, la Ciencia y la Cultura (UNESCO) en septiembre de 2007 y es la sexta reserva de biosfera de Vietnam. Esta es la reserva de biosfera más grande de las 11 reservas de biosfera en Vietnam con una superficie total de 1.299.795 ha. La reserva de biosfera es un corredor verde que une tres zonas centrales, incluido el Parque Nacional Pu Mat, la Reserva Natural Pu Huong y la Reserva Natural Pu Luong, para proporcionar continuidad de hábitat y hábitats para mantener una conservación efectiva de los ricos valores de biodiversidad del área. La reserva de biosfera está ubicada en los límites administrativos de 9 distritos montañosos de Anh Son, Con Cuong, Ky Son, Que Phong, Quy Chau, Quy Hop, Tan Ky, Thanh Chuong y Tuong Duong con un total de 182 comunas y ciudades. 2.125 aldeas en la provincia de Nghe An. Este es el hogar de 6 grupos étnicos: Thái, Thổ, Khơ Mú, Mông, Ở Đu y Kinh.
